To qualify for the program

- ✓ Must be a refugee, Cuban/Haitian entrant.
- ✓ Must be an asylee, or under the Amerasian or Human Trafficking Programs.
- ✓ Must have been in the US for less than five years.
- ✓ Must live in Orange, Osceola and Seminole counties (surrounding counties may be approved upon request).
